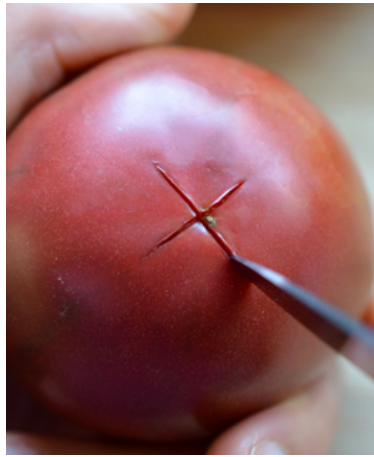

# Gigi's Kitchen:

## Watermelon Gazpacho



### INGREDIENTS:

2 pounds ripe tomatoes  
 1 medium red bell pepper  
 1 hothouse cucumber (approximately 1 pound)  
 2 small shallots, coarsely chopped  
 4 cilantro stalks  
 1 pound cubed watermelon (approximately 3 cups)  
 2 tablespoons raspberry vinegar  
 1/3 cup extra virgin olive oil, plus extra for garnish  
 1 teaspoon kosher salt  
 Freshly ground pepper

### INSTRUCTIONS:

Fill a large pot with water and bring it to a boil.

Cut a small "X" on the bottom of each tomato with a sharp knife and drop them into the water for 30 seconds.

When cooled off, peel and chop them.

Peel cucumber. Reserve 1/3 for garnish and chop the rest.

Dump shallots, cucumber, cilantro and tomatoes into your blender until pureed.

Cube and de-seed the watermelon.

When veggies are liquefied, add watermelon, raspberry vinegar, olive oil, salt and pepper.

Blend until smooth

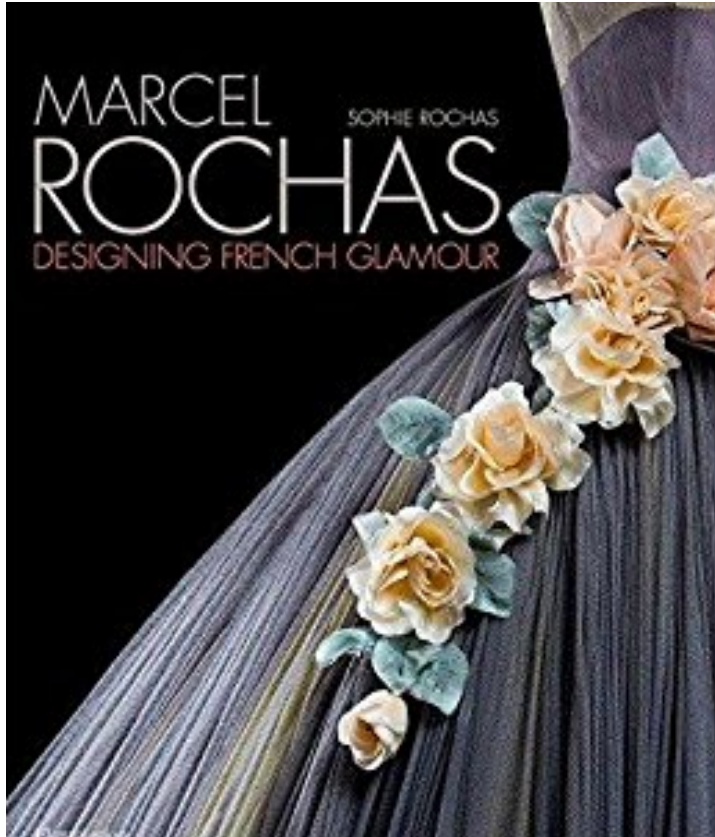
ET VOILA, LE TOUR EST JOUE!!!!

Refrigerate for 4 hours.

Before serving, top with a drizzle of olive oil, cucumber and fresh cracked pepper.

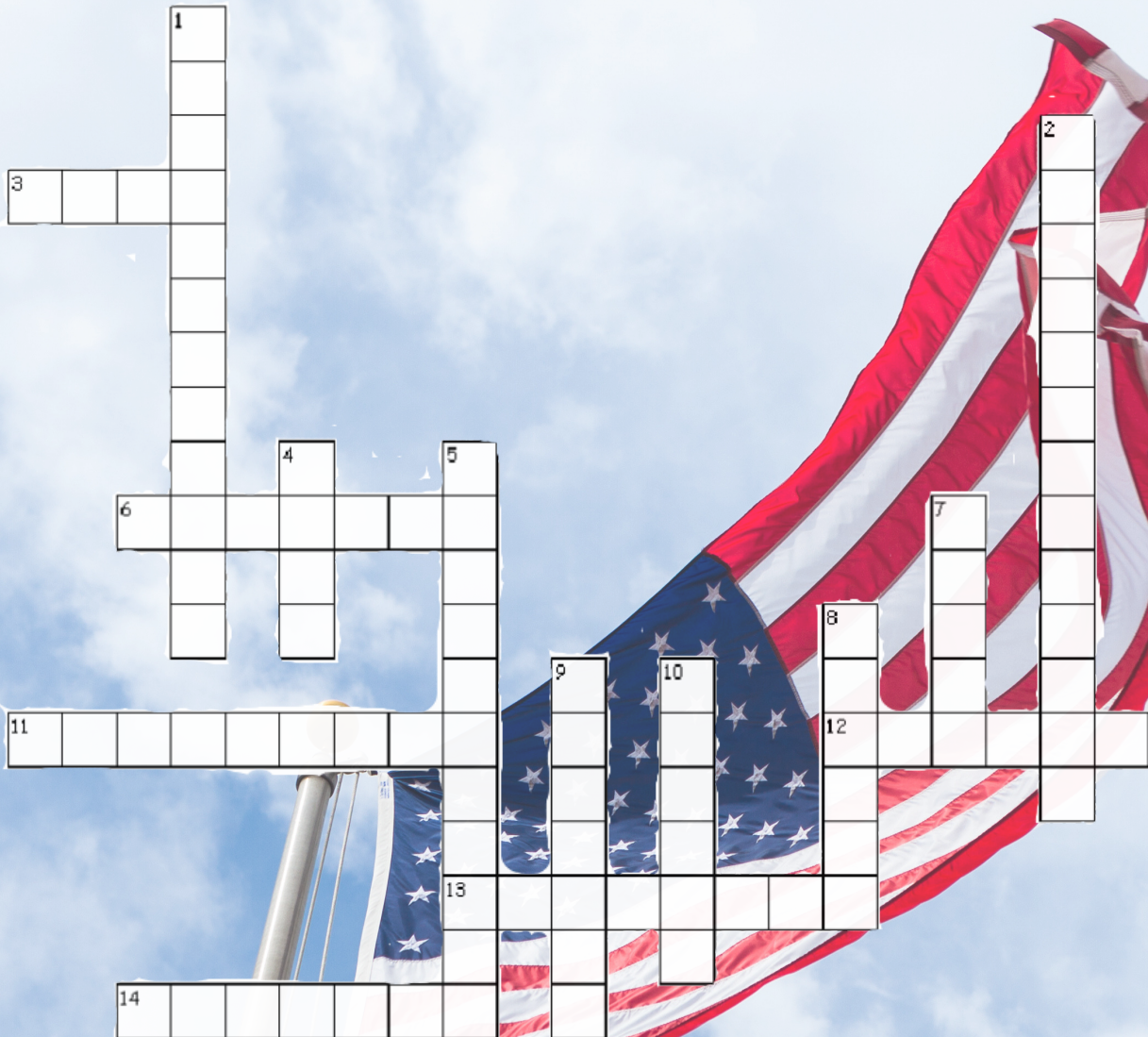
