GIGI'S KITCHEN

Crawfish Étouffée



INGREDIENTS

- 1/4 c. vegetable oil
- 1/3 c. flour
- 1 small green bell pepper, diced to 1/3-1/2 inch
- 1 medium onion, diced to 1/3-1/2 inch
- 2 ribs of celery, diced to 1/3-1/2 inch
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 c. fish stock (or clam juice)
- 2 medium tomatoes, peeled, seeded, and diced to 1/3-1/2 inch
- 1 bay leaf
- 1 1/2 t. fresh basil, copped
- 3/4 fresh thyme leaves
- 1-4 t. Tabasco
- 1 lb. frozen peeled crawfish tails, defrosted
- 1/2 c. green onions, thinly sliced on the bias
- Steamed white rice

Craw fish in the Christmas season?
YES!

The crawfish season in Louisiana starts in November and runs into June.

Folks start firing up their boiling pots even before Thanksgiving.

In the Carolinas, you easily find frozen crawfish or you can improve this dish with small local fresh shrimp.

Enjoy!

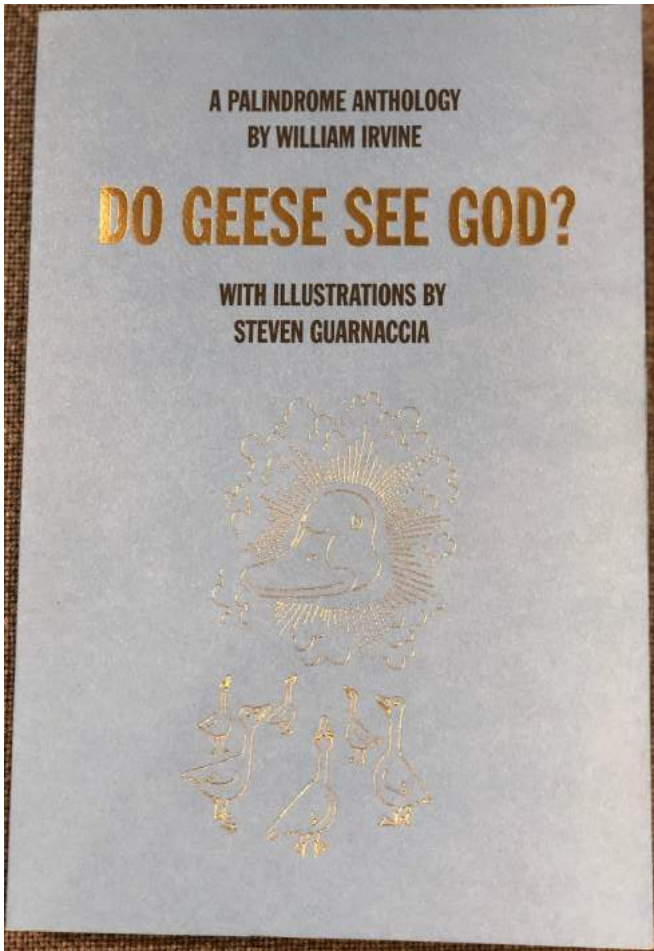
INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Add oil and flour to a large pot and heat over low to moderately low heat. Stir constantly for 15 to 30 minutes until the roux turns a deep, dark chocolate brown. Monitor the heat carefully so that the roux does not burn.
2. Add the peppers, onion and celery. Cook until softened, 5 to 10 minutes. Add the garlic and cook another 1 to 2 minutes.
3. Add the fish stock, tomatoes, bay leaf, basil and thyme. Increase heat, bring to a boil and reduce heat to simmer, stirring occasionally, until sauce thickens, about 15 minutes.
4. Add hot sauce, crawfish and scallions. Heat until the crawfish are warmed (or until uncooked shrimp are cooked, if using).
5. Serve hot with steamed white rice.

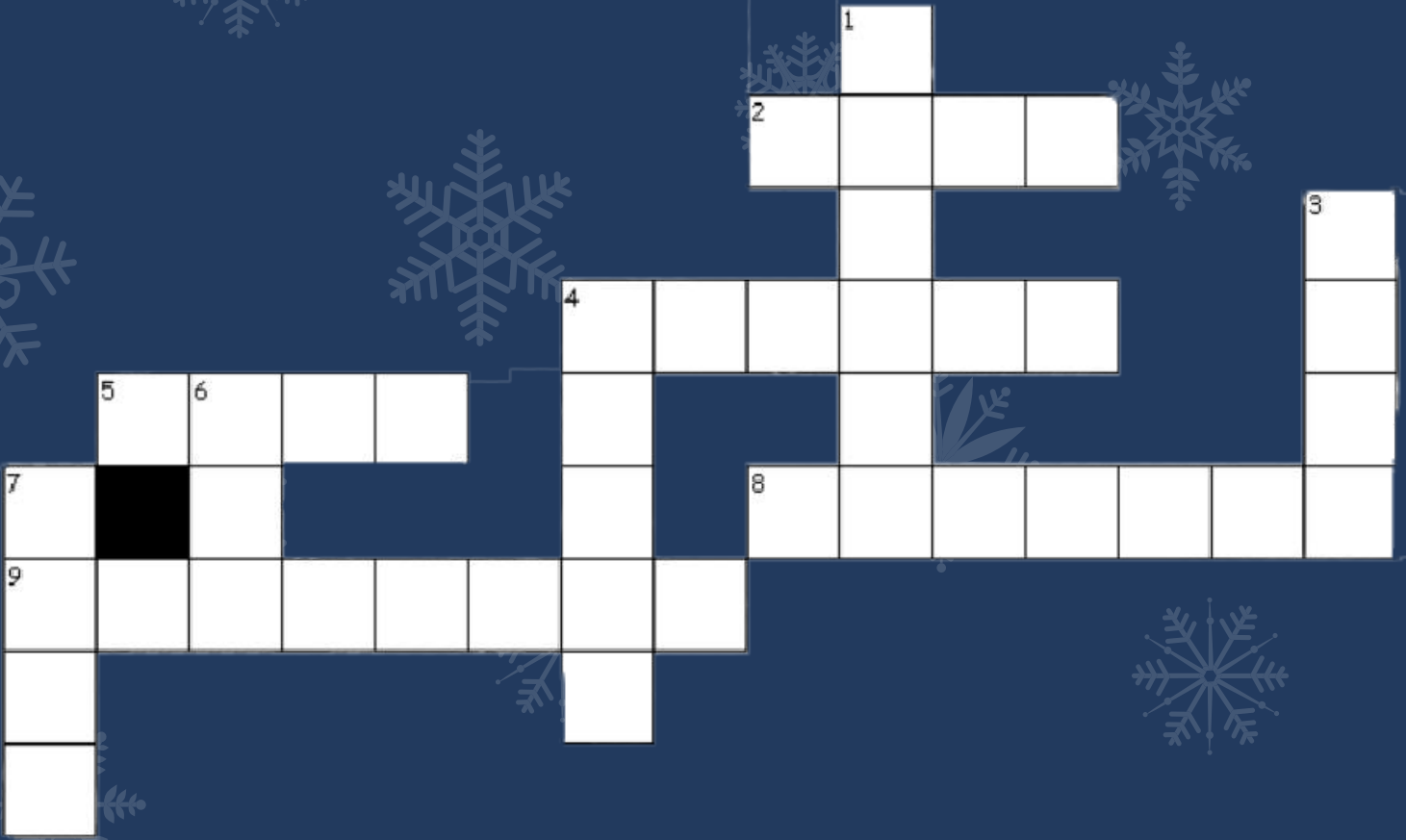
