GIGI'S KITCHEN

Watermelon Gazpacho

Ingredients

- 4 cups cubed watermelon, seeded, divided
- 2 tablespoons lime juice
- 1 tablespoon grated lime zest
- 1 teaspoon minced fresh gingerroot
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup chopped tomato
- 1/2 cup chopped cucumber
- 1/2 cup chopped green pepper
- 1/4 cup minced fresh cilantro
- 2 tablespoons chopped green onion
- 1 tablespoon finely chopped jalapeno pepper

Instructions

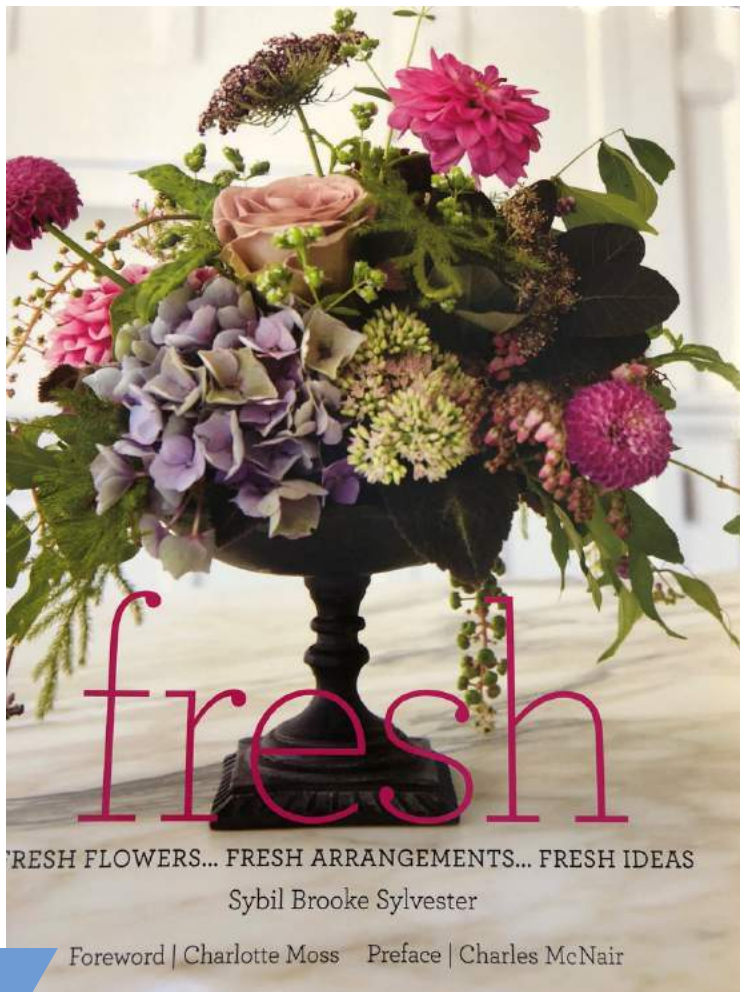
1. Puree 3 cups watermelon in a blender. Cut remaining watermelon into 1/2-inch pieces; set aside.
2. In a large bowl, combine the watermelon puree, lime juice, lime zest, ginger, and salt. Stir in the tomato, cucumber, green pepper, cilantro, onion, jalapeno and cubed watermelon. Chill until serving. If desired, serve with wedge of watermelon.

The United States Flag



The Stars and Stripes.

It's an emblematic American phrase we often use to refer to our flag, especially nearing Independence Day.

But what do the stars and stripes on the United States Flag really signify?

The original United States Flag was adopted on June 14th, 1777, holding 13 stars and 13 stripes to represent the thirteen original colonies. Following the adoption of the flag's design, lawmakers decided to mandate that for each new state that joined the union, there would be an additional star added to the flag, resulting in the fifty stars that it holds today.

There is historic meaning behind the red, white, and blue, too. Red symbolizes hardiness and valor, while white symbolizes purity and innocence, and blue represents vigilance, perseverance and justice. These three colors combined represent the authentic identity of the United States.

As we decorate our homes and celebrate our freedom adorned in bright red and blue this July, let us take a moment to remember the significance of the stars and stripes, and the history behind the flag that represents our country and our freedom.
